



Dear On-Campus Resident:

Fall 2019/Spring 2020 housing and roommate assignments will be available on the home page of *MyHousing* beginning July 23, 2019. Please check your assignment and contact your assigned roommate(s) to discuss living arrangements and any items you may want to share while living together.

Check the *Online Assignment Packet* at reslife.bloomu.edu/OAP and review the *Move-In Newsletter* as well as the other posted important information.

All room and roommate assignments are final. **We will not make any roommate changes based on any information or pictures found on social networking sites. No changes will be made unless we learn that your assigned roommate will not be attending Bloomsburg University.** Please check MyHousing often between July 23 and the start of the semester as we sometimes find out, after assignments are posted, that your assigned roommate will not be attending Bloomsburg University. If this occurs, you may be consolidated with another student who does not have a roommate and your assignment will be updated on MyHousing. Be sure to check frequently for any updates; as you will not receive notifications of any change via email or phone.

For returning students, your assignment is either a confirmation of the room and roommate that you selected during the HOST process or it reflects a change (consolidation) in your room assignment and/or roommate(s) because your roommate is no longer living on campus. If your roommate (who you selected during the HOST process) has not informed you of their intended change we apologize for informing you through this email. If you have any questions concerning why your roommate is not returning to campus housing in the fall semester, please contact him/her and not the Office of Residence Life. Because of confidentiality we will not be able to provide that information to you. All new roommates are matched based upon living preferences provided by you in MyHousing. Any changes between now and the start of the semester will be on MyHousing. Be sure to check frequently for any updates; as you will not receive notifications of any change via email or phone.

Apartment and Soltz Hall students, when checking your assignment on MyHousing, the bed number shown is the bedroom to which you will be given ID access.

Any updates or new information added to your MyHousing profile after July 1, may not have been taken into account when making your assignment. For example, if you have just recently answered your Personal Information questions indicating that you do or do not smoke, you may have already been placed with a roommate who does smoke because you had not completed your preferences at the time assignments were made. Similarly, if you entered any medical issues that affect your housing needs, we may not be able to accommodate those requests as we were unaware of them when making assignments.

If you no longer wish to live on-campus, it is important to submit an online housing release form so that we can release you. Go to reslife.bloomu.edu/notice-release-offer.php to do so. Please remember that if you are not returning to Bloomsburg or have decided to make other living arrangements you still must be released by this office or you will be held responsible for the cost of your on-campus housing. **Returning students please note:** If you submit a release form prior to the start of the semester to live off-campus, you will be charged a \$500 housing cancellation fee. We **will not** release students to live off-campus at any time during the academic year. If you choose to live off-campus anyway, you will be responsible for the full cost of your on-campus housing assignment.
