

Early Housing Selection Process

Secure your Fall 2019/Spring 2020 On-Campus Housing NOW!

HOST = Housing Options Selection Time

Students planning to live on-campus for Fall 2019/Spring 2020 must complete the **HOST** process to secure housing. There are 2 opportunities to complete the **HOST** process, the Early Commitment process occurring in October or the Traditional process occurring December through February.

Early Commitment **HOST** Process – Happening Now

Soltz Hall Suites and Upper Campus Apartments

Step 1: Complete the Fall 2019-Spring 2020 Academic Year Current Student Housing and Dining Agreement in *MyHousing Self-Service* between **October 8, 2018 and October 19, 2018**

Step 2: Answer the Personal Information questions and Request Roommate(s) in *MyHousing Self-Service* between October 8, 2018 and October 19, 2018

Step 3: Select your Fall 2019/Spring 2020 suite or apartment in *MyHousing Self-Service* during one of the Early Commitment Selection Process dates below:

Soltz Hall Same Suite Selection Process

October 23 & 24 7am – 9pm each day

- Open to current residents of Soltz Hall who want to select their same suite
- You must have a fully matched roommate group with the exact number of roommates requested in *MyHousing Self-Service* to fill the number of beds in the suite.
- The student currently living in the suite must be the one to select it for the group and place each roommate in the bedroom they want.

Same MPA, MOA, JKA Apartment Selection Process*

October 23 & 24 7am – 9pm each day

- Open to current residents of MPA, MOA or JKA who want to select their same apartment
- Partial roommate groups can select an apartment. However, if you choose to request a roommate(s), you must all do so in *MyHousing Self-Service* so that your group is fully matched.
- The student currently living in the apartment must be the one to select it. If you requested roommates, place each student in the bedroom they want.

Different or New to MPA, MOA, JKA Apartments Selection Process*

October 25 & 26 7am – 9pm each day

- Open to all students currently living on-campus apartment who want to select an apartment in MPA, MOA or JKA
- Partial roommate groups can select an apartment. However, if you choose to request a roommate(s), you must all do so in *MyHousing Self-Service* so that your group is fully matched.
- Any student living on-campus can select the apartment. If you requested roommates, place each student in the bedroom they want.

*Partial roommate groups can select an apartment but be aware, if there are vacancies in your apartment, other students will be able to assign themselves to those spaces. Students with apartment openings will either be consolidated or assigned random roommates by the Office of Residence Life prior to the start of the fall 2019/spring 2020 academic year.

Traditional **HOST** Process – Starting December 1 Residence Halls, Soltz Hall Suites and Upper Campus Apartments

Step 1: Complete the Fall 2019-Spring 2020 Academic Year Current Student Housing and Dining Agreement in *MyHousing Self-Service* between December 1, 2018 and January 31, 2019

Step 2: Answer the Personal Information questions and Request Roommate(s) in *MyHousing Self-Service* between December 1, 2018 and January 31, 2019

Step 3: Select your fall 2019/spring 2020 residence hall or apartment housing in *MyHousing Self-Service* during the selection dates in February

More details on the Traditional **HOST** process will be sent in November.

Housing Descriptions and Current Cost There will be an increase in cost for 2019-2020.

Jessica S. Kozloff Apartments (JKA): 4-person, 4 single bedrooms, kitchen, living room, 2 bathrooms; furnished, air-conditioned; wireless internet access; cable TV jacks in each bedroom and living room; laundry areas on each floor, parking at the complex, a community center which includes the main office for all apartment complexes, mailboxes and fitness center. There are NO ELEVATORS in the JKA Complex. Optional coed living. Dining Plan is optional.

Current Cost: \$4,106 + \$190 utilities per student per semester

Mt. Olympus Apartments (MOA): 6-person, 6 single bedrooms, kitchen, living room and bathroom on first floor; kitchenette and bathroom on second floor; furnished, air-conditioned; wireless internet access; cable TV jacks in each bedroom and living room; laundry rooms at the end of most apartment buildings, parking at the complex, mailboxes located at Monty's. Optional coed living. Dining Plan is optional. **Current cost:** \$3,988 + \$190 utilities per student per semester.

Montgomery Apartments (MPA): 2-person, 2 single bedrooms, kitchen, living room, 1 bathroom; furnished, air-conditioned; wireless internet access; 50" LCD television provided in living room; cable TV jack in each living room (not in bedrooms); laundry rooms at the end of every apartment building, parking at the complex, mailboxes located at Monty's. Optional coed living. Dining Plan is optional.

Current Cost: \$4,312 + \$230 for utilities per student per semester.

David L. Soltz Residential Suites: 1 to 4-person, single-bedrooms, 1 or 2 bathrooms depending on the number of bedrooms; furnished; in room heat and air conditioning temperature control; wireless internet access, cable TV jack and network jack in each bedroom and common area; visual fire alarms (strobe lights), pillow shaker jack in ADA bedrooms; laundry rooms on each floor. Dining Plan (either Plan A, B, C, E or G) required.

Current Cost: \$4,435/semester.

Traditional Residence Halls: Double (2-person room), Triad (3-person room) or Quad (4-person room) **Current Cost:** \$3,391/semester air conditioned or \$3,154/semester non-air conditioned. Suite (3 or 4-person, shared bedrooms with bathroom and air conditioning) **Current Cost:** \$3,744/semester. Single Room (1-person with air conditioning) **Current Cost:** \$4,435/semester. Dining Plan (either Plan A, B, C, E or G) required.
